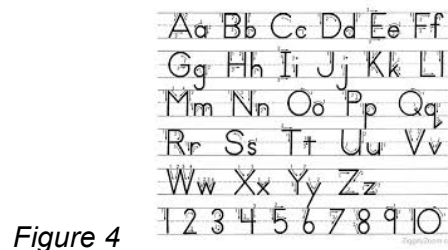
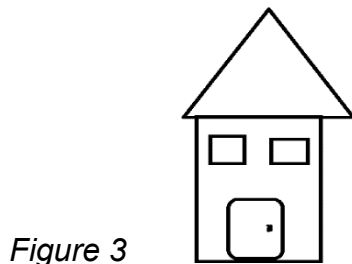
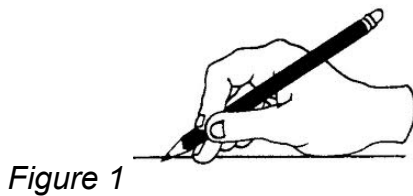


Fine/Visual Motor

- 🍏 Hand dominance is established
- 🍏 Uses mature pencil grasp with side of hand resting on the table and fingers moving the pencil (**Figure 1**)
- 🍏 Use hands together to cut with scissors, hold and turn paper, open and close a variety of containers
- 🍏 Starting to cut simple to more complex shapes with smooth rather than jagged edges (**Figure 2**)
- 🍏 Colours accurately within the lines
- 🍏 Builds complex structures from blocks, Lego or building toys
- 🍏 Draws with diagonal lines and other shapes combinations
- 🍏 Draws a person with six or more body parts
- 🍏 Draws recognizable pictures with more detail (**Figure 3**)
- 🍏 Prints legible upper and lower case letters and numbers (**Figure 4**)
- 🍏 Print letters and numbers along a line or within a box



Self-Care:

Dressing

- 🍏 Dresses/undresses independently
- 🍏 Able to tie a knot when beginning to tie laces (**Figure 5**)
- 🍏 Can manage most clothing fasteners, although tight waistbands with buttons, snaps or clasps may still be a challenge

- 🍏 Beginning to cut food

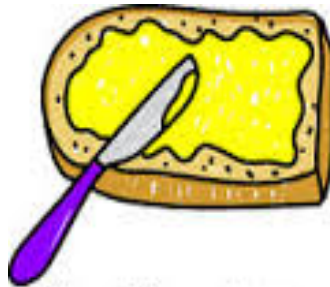
