- Collaborate with a multi-disciplinary team of professionals.

- Experience working with children with Autism and Applied Behavioural Analysis are definite assets.

- Must have an understanding of childhood development and comfort in appropriately engaging children and youth in play.
- Current first aid and CPR are required.
- Must be able to work successfully in a family-centred, and team environment.
